VIRGINIA SNAP UPDATE

On October 23, 2025, Virginia Governor, Glenn Youngkin, declared a State of Emergency to protect Virginian's whose SNAP will be affected due to the federal shutdown.

On October 28, 2025, Gov. Youngkin held a press conference to provide an announcement regarding SNAP and emergency food assistance. See details below.

VIRGINIA EMERGENCY NUTRITION ASSISTANCE (VENA)

Governor Youngkin explained that since the state isn't able to fund directly into the SNAP program, his administration has created a parallel food assistance program, Virginia Emergency Nutrition Assistance.

If the federal government shutdown has not ended by November 1, 2025, VENA will begin on November 3, 2025

An important change to note for SNAP recipients is that VENA will be funded on a <u>weekly basis</u> rather than once a month.

VENA SCHEDULE FOR SNAP ISSUANCE
